Art gallery dedicated to local artists. Stop in to shop and check out the latest exhibit!



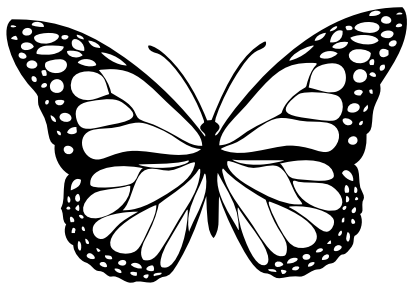
## MERMAID AT THE PORT

Mosaic tile mermaid designed and installed by local artist, Sandy Sanders at the Port of Prescott Hotel.



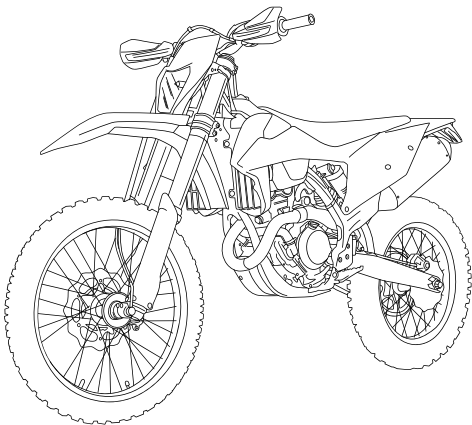
## ABE THE EAGLE
